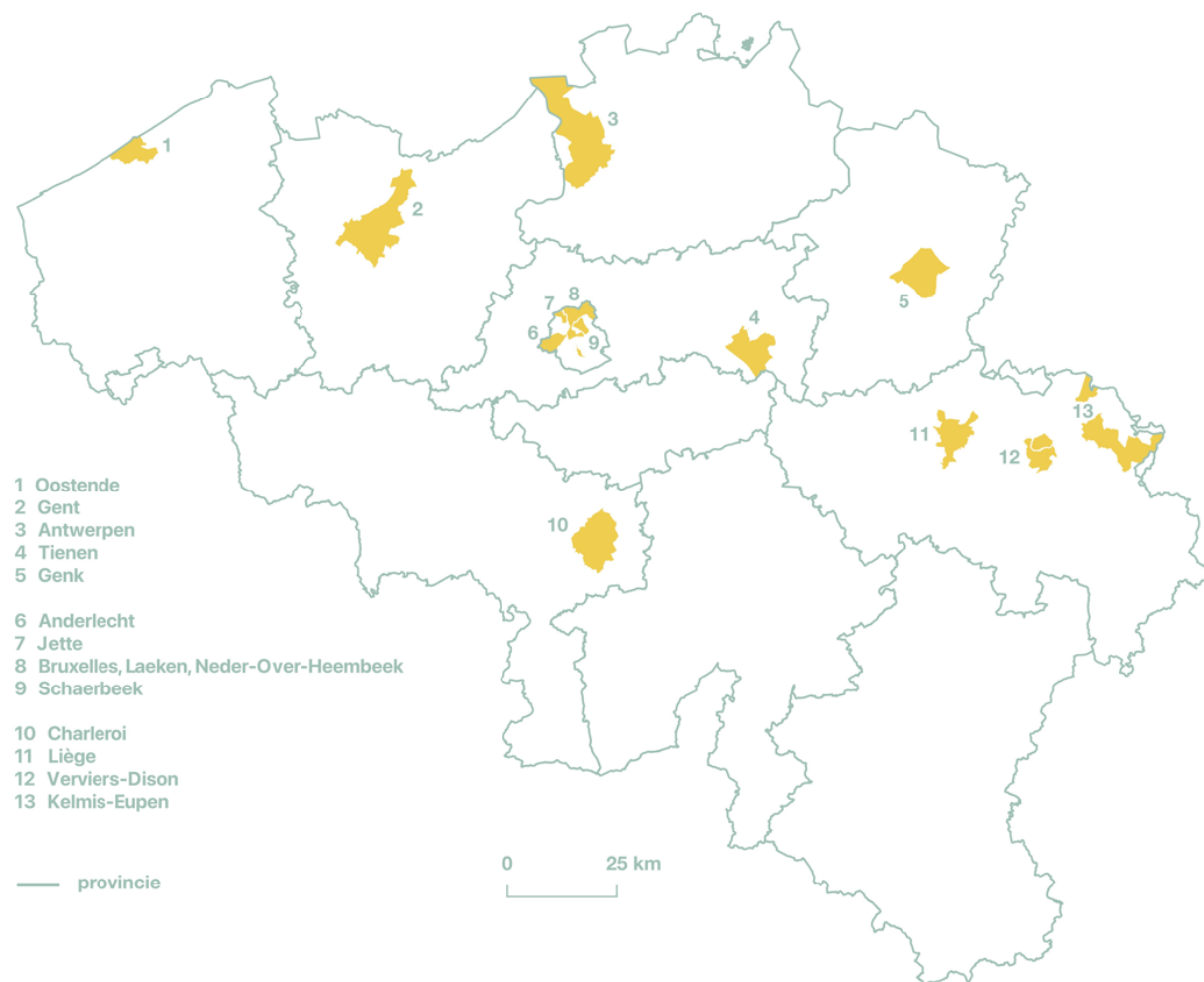




## Community Health Workers



### Help to reduce health inequalities

Act as a **liaison** between health and welfare services and the community in vulnerable neighbourhoods

**Facilitate access** to services and improve service quality

**Increase knowledge** about health and self-reliance

**Sensitize** health and welfare professionals on the importance of appropriate communication

**Inform** them about the effects of social determinants for health on the lives of patients and their care

### Key figures

- In **2022** our CHWs reached **20 785** persons through group interventions
- **4901** individuals were received personal follow up
- On average, a follow up included **3,25** interventions



### Diverse target audience

- **50%** between **31** and **55** years of age
- **53%** men, **47%** women
- **109** nationalities
- **36%** without formal education
- **31%** no income
- **76%** have difficulties to make ends meet



### Most frequent CHW roles:



1. Bridge builder between individuals, communities and health actors
2. Provide coaching and social support
3. Navigator in the health system
